Subject: First Information Report against Deputy Superintendent of Police (Traffic)

Dear Sir/Madam,

We would like to file an FIR against Deputy Superintendent of Police, Mr. Bashan J Laloo.

Following is how the incident involving Mr Bashan J Laloo unfolded on the 19<sup>th</sup> December 2018 at about 7-7.30 pm.

- I was driving a maruti 800 car bearing registration no. AS01 E 6188 and overtook some cars on the St. Edmunds School Road.
- When I reached fire brigade (near tit bits), my friend, Dharmesh Parmar from Bombay and I were greeted by a black bolero. A constable knocked on my window and asked if I had a license. Then a man with a name tag, "Laloo" pulled me out of the car.
- Before even asking anything, this police officer forcefully took me out of the car and beat me up hysterically like he was drunk and spoke to me in Hindi and did not let me speak.
- When I asked him in Khasi why he was beating the life out of me when I was just overtaking some cars, he replied instead, "If this was Garo Hills I would have just shot you"
- After this, they took me and my friend to the Laitumkhrak Traffic Police. I was feeling too sick and dizzy from the violent attack with the lathi that I went directly to the bathroom to vomit.
- When I got back, some police officers asked me to sit down because they could see I was in a lot of pain. The police officer, Laloo came back and started poking me and my friend with his Lathi and shouted at the other policemen for letting me sit down. He then took me to another room where he forcefully made me sit on the floor while he lit a cigarette and continued shouting at me calling me a drunk and a drug user.
- He then left the police station and we did not hear from him again.
- The other policemen there then took us to Civil hospital and having done the tests including the alcohol and drug test, the medical report is as follows:
  - Fractured index finger
  - Bruised Legs
  - No trace of alcohol, no trace of drugs

This is a serious case of abuse of power, breach of law by a public servant, grievous violent attack and attempt to murder, verbal abuse, intimidation that included illegal confinement and a serious case of racism and classism where he was judging me because of my dreadlocks and appearance. He beat me up



and only stopped because I spoke to him in Khasi. He would have taken my life if this did not happen on the main road and this is a serious human rights violation.

After visiting Civil hospital, we went back to the police station to collect the car during which time we asked for the full name and designation of Laloo and we were told it is Bashan J Laloo, DSP Traffic East Khasi HDs.

We therefore file this FIR for necessary criminal investigation and prosecution into the matter. We also put forward the following demands:

- Immediate suspension of Bashan J Laloo, and termination post inquiry
- Reimbursements for all my medical tests and checkups and subsequent medical expenses resulting from this injury
- I am a pianist and musician. Owing to this violent attack and injury to my hand and fingers, I have had to cancel many upcoming gigs. This loss has to be compensated.
- Further, any long term negative impact on my musical career owing to this injury also has to be taken into consideration while awarding compensation.

Request you to kindly look into the matter because Mr. B. J Laloo is a repeat offender and serial violent abuser and had previously assaulted someone until they were severely injured and hospitalized ( reports attached)

Request you to kindly look into this at the earliest and to do the needful as per law.
